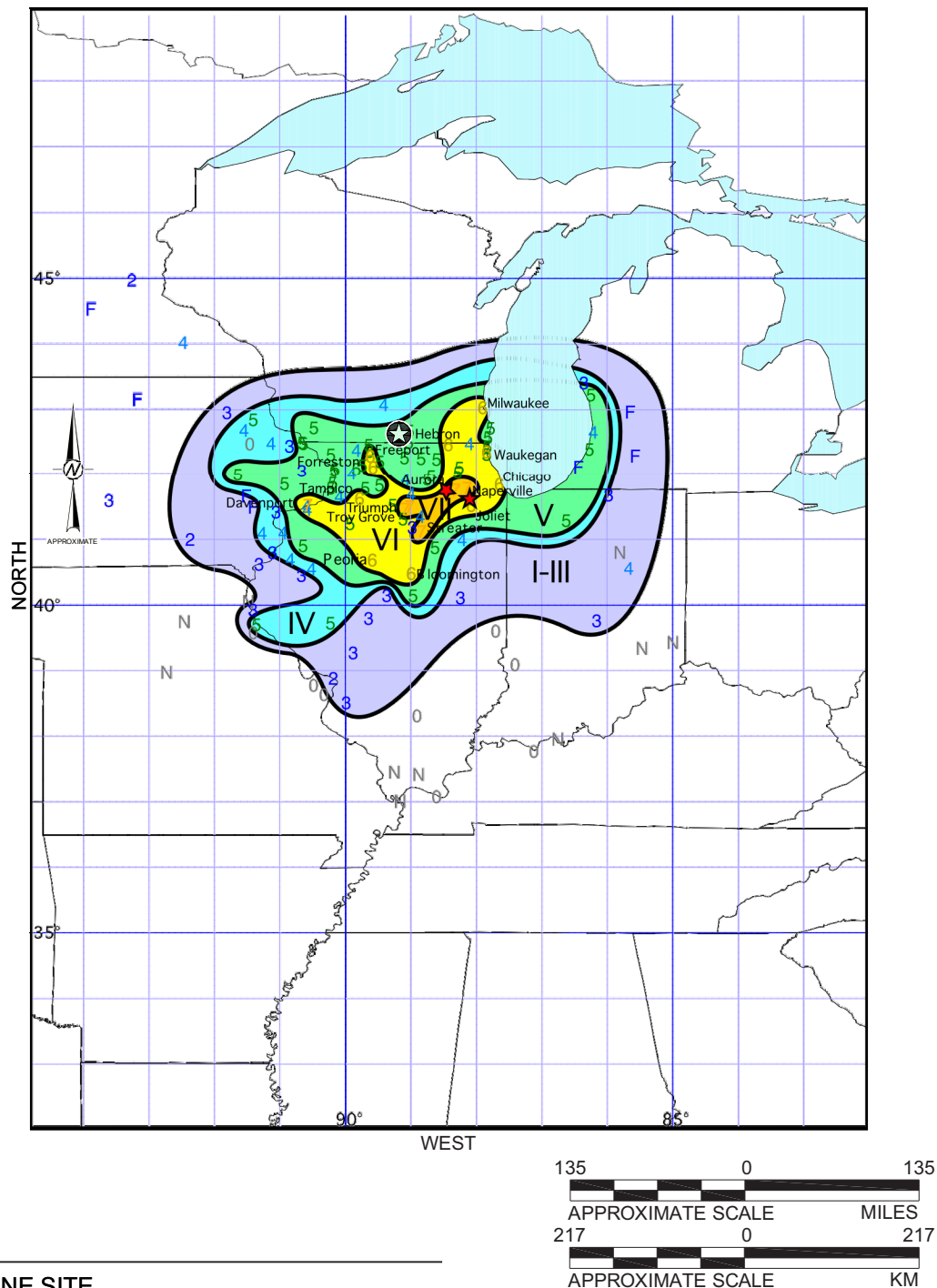


Figure 2.5-17 – Iseoseismal Map May 26, 1909 Earthquake
