LTC Fota returned my call. I discussed that on January 2, 2013, we had a phone call to discuss their request to defer the NRC regulatory oversight to the Army Reactor Office of the Diamond Ordnance Reactor Facility (DORF) decommissioning, which was requested in August 25, 2011 letter. In the January meeting, I discussed that to pursue the deferral, the license needed to be placed in suspension, and what was required to have that happen was discussed. The Army was to review this method and determine if that is how they wanted to pursue this activity. The Army plans to submit site specific DCGLs and surveys to have the DORF released. I discussed since they were not pursuing the license suspension, that the action should be closed. LTC Fota concurred. I said if they needed to pursue this option in the future, that I would maintain the information about the process for license suspension.
