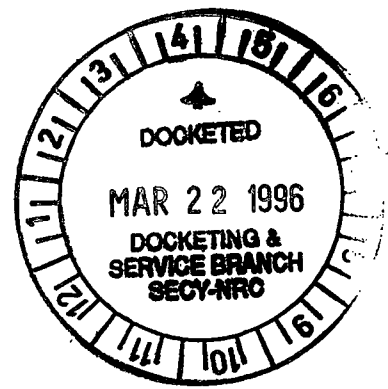

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.7111, State of Oklahoma respectfully requests that it be given additional time in which to file an amicus brief as authorized in the Commission's Order of February 27, 1996 in CLI-96-3.

State of Oklahoma was never officially served with a copy of the Commission's February 27, 1996 Order because it was apparently not included in the mailing.

At a later date, the State of Oklahoma was informed by another party to this action of the Commission's February 27, 1996 decision.

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

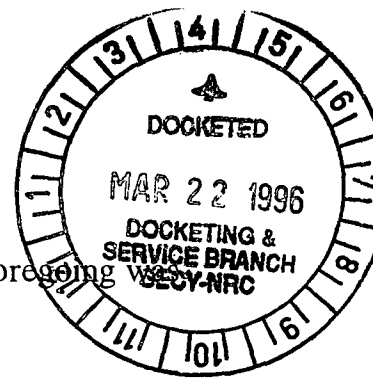

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
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
