
Subject: Clinton Annual Dose Report for 2012

Pursuant to 10 CFR 20.2206, "Reports of individual monitoring," paragraph (c), the Annual Dose Report covering the previous year shall be submitted on or before April 30th of each year. The Annual Dose Report provides the results of individual radiation monitoring for each Clinton Power Station individual for whom radiation monitoring was provided during 2012. The data file containing this report was submitted electronically via the Radiation Exposure and Information Reporting System (REIRS) internet web page on April 15, 2013.

The electronically submitted file contains Personally Identifiable Information (PII), therefore, pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," we are requesting that the enclosed information be exempt from public disclosure.
