Please let me know if the following statement is true:

"The NRC is approximately two years away from promulgating regulations addressing Beyond Design Basis events such as great quakes and tsunamis, yet they plan to make their restart decision within a couple of months - before they have fully addressed all circumstances that could result in a catastrophic meltdown.
