Dear Diane:

As you are no doubt aware, counsel for General Atomics ("GA") in the above-captioned matter indicated in a letter to you dated August 21, 1995 that both GA and Sequoyah Fuels Corporation ("SFC") would be filing responses today to the Intervenor's motion to compel production of documents. However, on August 24, 1995, the NRC Staff and GA filed a Joint Motion seeking a temporary stay of all activities in this proceeding in order to permit settlement negotiations, and the Intervenor has indicated that they would not oppose such a stay subject to certain conditions. The NRC Staff and GA have been asked to express their views on that response by 2:00 PM on August 29, and it appears that the Board is likely to rule on this matter within the next forty-eight hours.

I tried to reach you today at both your Washington, DC and Maryland offices to request your consent that SFC and GA defer filing their respective responses to the Intervenor's motion to compel production of documents pending the Board's ruling on the request for a stay. Unfortunately, I was unable to reach you to discuss this matter. Under the circumstances, it appears appropriate to defer filing the GA and SFC responses pending the Board's decision. SFC and GA intend to promptly file their responses if the joint motion for a stay is denied.
