INTERVENORS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO RESPOND TO JOINT MOTION FOR APPROVAL
OF NRC STAFF-GENERAL ATOMCS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

SERVED JUL 24 1996

On July 11, 1996, the NRC staff and General Atomics submitted NRC Staff's and General Atomics' Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement by first-class mail. Pursuant to NRC regulations at 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.730(c) and 2.710, answers to the motion are due on July 26, 1996.

Intervenors, Native Americans for a Clean Environment ("NACE") and the Cherokee Nation, hereby request a two-week extension of the July 26 deadline until August 9, 1996. The additional time is needed because one of intervenors' counsel has been unable to devote sufficient time to the proposed settlement, due to the conflicting demands of the Yankee Rowe decommissioning case, an expedited proceeding in which she represents the petitioners. In addition, the proposed settlement, taken together with the SFC-NRC staff settlement, is a novel and complex matter which requires a substantial investment of time by intervenors in order to make a meaningful review.

Counsel for both GA and the NRC staff have authorized intervenors to represent that they do not object to intervenors'
