Hi Mr. Padilla,

The NRC is planning on replenishing your KI for 2015. According to my records, we will replenish Arizona with 51,390 (65mg tablets) in 2015, Lot#TU905A, expiring in July 2015.

- 2,570 boxes x 20 tablets = 51,390 (65 mg tablets)

Just to clarify in your e-mail below, the doses we are currently sending are 65mg. Please let me know if you have any additional questions. I will be in contact with you prior to delivery in 2015.

Hi Toby,

The County received 680 packages of 20 tablet/65mg in 2012 for a total of 6,800 120mg doses. We used these tablets to replace expired liquid KI in our inventory.

Here are the 2013 County KI numbers:

2012 EPZ Population: 13,081

KI Inventory:

- 3,970 packages of 20/65mg tablets each.
- 160 packages or 1,600 120mg doses have been provided to MCSO for Emergency Workers.
- That leaves 3,810 packages or 38,100 120mg doses for the General Public.

720 packages of 20/65mg tablets will expire in May 2013 for a reduction of 7,200 120mg doses. Which will leave 30,900 120mg doses or sufficient capacity for 15,450 individuals at 2 doses each which covers the current EPZ population plus a surplus for an additional 2,369 individuals.

We can use the surplus to cover the estimated 20% shadow evacuation of 2,600 individuals or make it available to Emergency Workers who may respond as part of SWAT, USAR, Bomb squad or HAZMAT as identified in the REP Program Manual, unless ARRA has sufficient inventory to cover those Emergency Workers.

Our next lot if KI to expire is TU905A which will expire in July 2015. That is composed of 2,570 packages of 20/65mg or 25,700 120mg doses. Please let us know if NRC plans to replace that inventory or issue an extension letter.
