SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE MARCH 11, 2013, PUBLIC MEETING BETWEEN
THE U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION AND THE
PRESSURIZED WATER REACTOR OWNERS GROUP EXECUTIVE
COMMITTEE

On March 11, 2013, a Category 2 public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and the Pressurized Water Reactor Owners Group (PWROG) Executive Committee (EC) in the Brookside Conference Room of the Bethesda North Marriott, 5701 Marinelli Road, Rockville, MD 20852. The PWROG EC desired to discuss PWROG organizational changes and the status of regulatory issues affecting the PWROG with NRC Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) management. A list of meeting attendees is enclosed and the meeting agenda dated February 28, 2013, is available in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML13059A178.

The meeting began with the introduction of attendees and opening remarks by EC Chairman, Randy Edington, and NRR Deputy Director, Dan Dorman. PWROG Chairman, Jack Stringfellow, started the presentation by informing the NRR management of the various PWROG organizational changes since the 2012 meeting. Mr. Stringfellow then led a review of the PWROG/NRC actions from the 2012 meeting. The floor was relinquished to PWROG Licensing Subcommittee Chairman, Rob Slough, who led a discussion on Topical Report activities. Next, various PWROG members led the discussions of the regulatory issues of mutual interest to the PWROG and NRC. The topics of discussions included: PWROG response to post Fukushima NRC orders and recommendations and the PWROG program to address Generic Safety Issue (GSI) 191. The slide presentation used during the PWROG EC presentation is available in ADAMS at Accession No. ML13109A514.

The NRR management then led a discussion of other issues of mutual interest. The topics of discussion included: Gas Accumulation, Onsite Emergency Response Capabilities, and Formation of a GSI-191 EC.
