Mr. Fell was contacted to get clarification on the street addresses for the US Silica Company and to verify the manufacturer, model, activity, and location of the devices authorized on the license. License condition 10A identifies a storage location at Route 522 North, Berkeley Springs, WV plant. This location is identified as a corporate address. Mr. Fell said the address is actually a former corporate office which is now a laboratory and no licensed material is, or will be, stored there. He said the laboratory used to have a gas chromatograph that was licensed, but that item had been disposed of. I also asked Mr. Fell to provide the inventory of their NRC licensed devices in order to ensure the license was accurate. Mr. Fell said he would provide a letter requesting the laboratory address be removed from Condition 10 and attesting to the fact that no licensed material remains there, only sealed sources were ever used/stored and the sealed source leak test were conducted and no leaking sources were ever identified. Mr. Fells also said he would provide a list of the sealed sources and devices possessed.
