Thank you for the opportunity to comment on NUREG 1556 Vol. 4 Rev. 1 "Draft Program-Specific Guidance About Fixed Gauge Licenses. Florida's Bureau of Radiation Control comments are below.

The draft guide makes multiple references to the Sealed Source and Device Registration certificate (SSD) where regulatory compliance information is contained.

These references are in Section 8.5.1 Sealed Sources and Devices, 8.6 Item 6: Purposes for Which Licensed Material Will Be Used, 8.9 Item 9: Facilities and Equipment, 8.10.6 Operating and Emergency Procedures, 8.10.7 Leak Tests, 8.10.8 Maintenance, and in the Checklists.

The Sealed Source and Device Registration Certificates are located in a secure database maintained by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and are not available to the public.

NUREG 1556 Volume 4 should contain a statement "To obtain information on regulatory compliance listed in the SSR the licensees, applicants, or other parties should contact the manufacturer or distributor of the device."
