Dear Mr. Wilson:


In response to your requests stated in the above referenced email, we commit to the following:

1. The gauge manufacturer, distributor or other person authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State will perform non-routine operations such as installation, initial radiation survey, repair, and maintenance of components related to the radiological safety of the gauge, gauge relocation, replacement, and disposal of sealed sources, alignment, or removal of a gauge from service.
2. Before obtaining licensed materials, the proposed RSO will have successfully completed the training described in Criteria in the section "Individual(s) Responsible for Radiation Safety Program and Their Training and Experience – Radiation Safety Officer" in NURG-1556, Vol. 4, dated October 1998.

Before being named as the RSO, future RSOs will have successfully completed the training described in Criteria in the section "Individual(s) Responsible for Radiation Safety Program and Their Training and Experience – Radiation Safety Officer" in NURG-1556, Vol. 4, dated October 1998. Within 30 days of naming a new RSO, we will submit the new RSO's name to the NRC to include in our license.
