SUMMARY

We have reviewed your new license request and find that we are unable to continue this action until we have received information regarding the following:

1. The NRC Form 313 submitted with your application was signed by you, as a partner in the organization. Please describe your position and the organizational structure of your company, clearly explaining how you meet the criteria of "a person duly authorized to act for and on [behalf of DNM, Inc.]. **In the March 11, 2013, phone conversation you indicated that you are one of two owners of the company. No additional information is needed in response to this item.**
2. Your application is unclear as to the total number of gauges or devices to be used and/or possessed by your company. Please submit all manufacturers and/or model numbers you may possess, the isotopes to be possessed per gauge, and the maximum quantity of radioactive material in each gauge. Also note the intended uses of the gauges, and an overall radioactive materials possession limit, by isotope. Include a statement that use will be in accordance with that specified in the SS and D certificate. **In the March 11, 2013, phone conversation you indicated that you would submit the requested materials information in writing.**
3. Your application included your training and experience relative to your request to be named as the Radiation Safety Officer, and we noted that training documentation referenced courses as far back as 1987. Please indicate your recent experience with portable gauges, including any manufacturer-provided or other hands-on courses. Consider training course criteria noted in NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, Appendix D, page D-1, when submitting any response. **In the March 11, 2013, phone conversation you indicated that you have been using radioactive gauges from 2006 forward. Please outline any post-1987 hands-on manufacturer training courses completed, with your response.**

4. In reviewing your application, we noted that commitments provided reference an outdated version of our NUREG 1556 guidance. Please refer to NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, and resubmit any commitments confirming adherence to NRC guidance. See Appendix B of the referenced guidance, pages B-3 to B-4, for the suggested language to use when submitting requested commitments. **In the March 11, 2013, phone conversation you confirmed that you would resubmit the revised commitments.**
5. Facility diagrams need not be submitted with requests to use portable gauges. In the future, please do not include facility diagrams in submissions to the NRC. **No additional information is requested in response to this item.**
6. Please note that a pre-licensing site visit is required for new radioactive materials licenses. **The pre-licensing site visit was completed at your facility on March 20, 2013. No response is required for this item.**

We have requested you submit the requested information –

- Portable gauge information including model numbers and total possession limits, etc.
- Recent RSO training & experience documentation
- Revised commitments, referencing NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1

- via facsimile, to (630) 515-1078. **Include a signed, dated cover letter with any response.** Please reference the Control No. 580020, as listed at the top of this memo. We expect hear from you on or before April 10, 2013.

For future reference, please always include the name, phone number and fax number of at least one person whom we may contact for additional information when reviewing your licensing correspondence and requests.

Please submit the requested information within 30 days of this record. **Include reference control number 580020, Please FAX your response to my attention at (630) 515-1078.** You may also scan your response and send to me via email, as a pdf file.
