Enclosed is an application, dated April 26, 2013, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from GE-Hitachi Nuclear Energy Americas LLC requesting amendment No. 07 to its existing license, XR135/06. The license presently authorizes the export to Taiwan of two 1,350 MWe (4,005 MWt) Advanced Boiling Water Reactors, to be built at Taiwan Power Nuclear Units, Lungmen 1 and 2.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) amend the name of the "Intermediate Foreign Consignee(s)," and 2) extend the expiration date from June 30, 2013 to June 30, 2018.

Since no substantive changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license are requested, our office is processing this as minor amendment. Therefore, the NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
