5/7/2013 (11:00) J. Richard Pooler was not in and I left a message for him to get back in touch with me concerning the financial assurance for the Bristol-Myers facility in Wallingford, CT. (11:50) Mr. Smith returned my call on behalf of Mr. Pooler. I went over the letter that would be issued accepting the Stand-by Trust Agreement (STA) signed September 14, 2012. The STA would need to be amended if the licensee changed its financial assurance instrument and needed to put in a date of "October 3, 2003" for Schedule A. I went over an abbreviated method of amending the STA rather than submitted it in its entirety. Then I informed Mr. Smith that the NRC has been receiving monthly escrow account statements from JP Morgan. Since the NRC did not allow escrow accounts as financial instruments as of December 17, 2012, the letter provided permission for the licensee to close the account. Mr. Smith then explained that the licensee no longer qualified for a self-guarantee and was seeking a letter of credit from a financial institution. He expected to have the Letter of Credit in hand prior to the end of May. I informed Mr. Smith that the Self-Guarantee would remain in place until the Letter of Credit and revised STA were accepted.
