The Office of the Secretary has received via E-Filing on May 6, 2013, a petition for leave to intervene and request for a hearing from the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League, Bellefonte Efficiency and Sustainability Team, and Mothers Against Tennessee River Radiation. This request was submitted in response to the *Federal Register* (78FR14362; March 5, 2013) notice issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff that provided: Notice of Acceptance for Docketing of Application and Notice of Opportunity of Hearing Regarding Renewal of Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2 Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-77 and DPR-79 for an additional 20-Year Period.
