SUBJECT

C/N 580078 for Cardinal Health License Number 34-32840-01 and status of decommissioning financial assurance for Cardinal Health License Number 34-32840-01 (East Lansing location).

SUMMARY

The purpose of the telephone call was to follow-up on the status of decommissioning financial assurance (DFA) for Cardinal Health – East Lansing's (CH) NRC cyclotron-production license.

The call was initiated with Jean Chisnell of Michigan State University (MSU) with a follow-up call to Willie Regits and Dan Hill of CH.

MSU has agreed to absorb the cost of decommissioning the cyclotron that CH is licensed for because MSU owns the cyclotron and property where it is located.

In MSU's letter dated 11/5/12 the university estimated that the cost to decommissioning the cyclotron would be \$500,000. However, they did not provide the basis for that estimate.

In the conversation with Ms. Chisnell I requested two things: 1) that MSU provide the basis for the cost estimate; and 2) that in lieu providing stand-alone DFA for the cyclotron, they revise their existing DFA to include the cost. Currently we have an approved DFA dated 2007 for MSU in the form of a statement of intent (SOI) in the amount of \$1,125,000 for MSU's two NRC licenses. I requested that Ms. Chisnell/MSU update that SOI to include the cost to decommission the cyclotron under NRC license number 34-32840-01.

Ms. Chisnell stated that she would need some time to determine how MSU came up with \$500,000 cost estimate.

I told Ms. Chisnell that I would contact CH and explain the above to them as well.

I contacted Dan Hill and Willie Regits of CH to inform them of the call that I had with Ms. Chisnell. Part of CH's amendment request dated 2/20/13 (C/N 580078) included a request for NRC to remove L/C #20. They felt that since MSU agreed to take responsibility for the DFA, L/C 20 was no longer needed to be on the license.

I explained that the purpose of L/C 20 was added for us to track the status of DFA until it gets approved. Since DFA has not yet been approved, we will not remove the L/C.

Mr. Regits also stated that CH developed the cost basis for the DFA and provided it to MSU. He will work with MSU to make sure that we get this information.


