Subject: Notice of Intent to Resume Operations at Metropolis Works

On October 15, 2012, the NRC issued a Confirmatory Order to Honeywell (Reference 2). Section IV of that Order outlined a number of actions that Honeywell must complete before it could resume operations at the Metropolis Works facility in Metropolis, Illinois. Since then, Honeywell has undertaken detailed analyses and performed extensive plant modifications to address the items in the Order. Each of the items required for resumption of operations has been or will be completed as follows:

As required by Section IV.4 of the Confirmatory Order, Honeywell is submitting this request for NRC authorization to resume operations. Honeywell does not intend to resume operations until at least June 8, 2013. In any event, Honeywell will not resume

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licensed operations until the NRC grants authorization in writing. Honeywell will continue to communicate with the NRC on the status of the remaining activities.
