Purpose

The purpose of this letter is to request the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) grant the Curtiss-Wright Electro-Mechanical Corporation an Interim Approval to Operate up to 90 days under “Curtiss-Wright Classified Services Network System Security Plan,” CW-ADP-01, Rev. 2 dated March 2010. Additionally, we request the NRC review and approve a new cyber security plan, “ACP-CW Classified Service Network Systems Security Plan (SSP),” CW-SSP-01, dated April 29, 2013.

Discussion

Enclosure 1 of this letter provides a new cyber security plan for Curtiss-Wright Electro-Mechanical Corporation which implements the requirements of “Energy Programs

Action


USEC requests NRC take the following actions:
