**General Comment**

Concerning the Strata Energy proposed ISL uranium mine in Crook County Wyoming I am asking that the NRC stop relying on its Generic EIS and fully consider the likely impacts to water and land resources from uranium mining.

Consider the high volumes of water need for this type mining and the fact that no mining company has yet restored water to pre-mining quality or quantity leaving water and ground pollution. Before allowing any additional uranium mining, the toxic contamination left by over 1000 previous wells should be corrected to pre-drilling quality.

The NRC needs to consider the full impact of the four proposed projects within the area of the "Ross Project", including the potential drawdown of water needed for drinking and livestock, dust pollution (possibly toxic) from the large increase of truck traffic, and the likely multiple instances of leakage and excursions from the drill sites.
