Dear Dr. Lewis:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 32 to your NRC Material License No. 24-24660-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

In addition, we removed Condition 14 regarding the decommissioning financial assurance requirement from your license because it does not apply to the scope of your program.

Please note that we did not add Maryanne Tran, M.D. as an authorized user for 10 CFR 35.200 and 35.300 (limited to the oral administration of sodium iodide I-131) to your license. The American Board of Radiology certificate, training and experience provided in your letter received February 11, 2013, was not sufficient to add Dr. Tran to your license at this time. If you wish to pursue this matter in the future, please provide the training specified in 10 CFR 35.290(c)(1) and (2) and 10 CFR 35.394(c)(1), (2) and (3).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011.
