If you were to walk into the nuclear plant at San Onofre today and judged it with the same standards that you would require of a new plant there is no question that you would never allow it to operate. A design that is faulty; agreed upon by yourselves, the company that made the steam generators, Edison, a plant with a history of the most infractions of any other US plant and questionable safety issues due to fault lines.
