Per the message below and the attachment, this is the equipment that the CRDM project purchased. Both the scanner and probe are contaminated, so I doubt very much that you want those sent to the NRC. We would prefer not to dispose of them as they are still usable- potentially on follow-on work or other projects.

As such, it would be best if you either asked them to be assigned to a different NRC project that PNNL is still funded to work on or you release them to be reassigned as DOE Accountable property.

Please let me know ASAP the disposition pathway for the three items.
