Dear Mr. Grant:

This is in reference to the letter dated August 12, 2013, from Bond, Schoeneck & King, PLLC, providing financial assurance for decommissioning for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-27843-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

The Standby Trust Agreement (STA) cannot be accepted as written. The STA allows payment into the STA of monies from financial assurance provided to multiple regulatory agencies (the NRC, the State of New Jersey, and the State of New York). The NRC requires that the financial assurance instrument provided for the NRC license pay into its own STA, so that monies from the Letter of Credit for the NRC license are used solely for decommissioning of the NRC license. Please submit an STA that lists only the NRC as a regulatory agency who is the beneficiary of the funds from this Letter of Credit.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Academic, and Industrial Uses of Nuclear Material**; then **Regulations, Guidance, and Communications**. You may also obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-866-512-1800. The GPO is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays).

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture. We strongly encourage you to review this material and adapt it to your particular needs in order to develop and maintain a positive safety culture as you engage in NRC-regulated activities.
