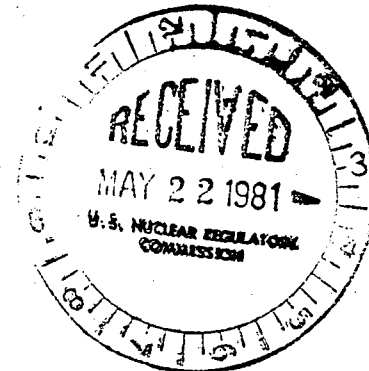

SCE's letter of May 15, 1981 submitted Amendment No. 24 to the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) and Amendment No. 6 to the "Fire Hazards Analysis and Comparison with Appendix A of NRC Branch Technical Position 9.5-1, October, 1977" for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3. The letter indicated that direct distribution of the amendments would be made within ten days of docketing in accordance with the service list provided in SCE's letter of October 29, 1979 to the Commission. In addition, SCE stated that an affidavit would be provided affirming that the distribution had been made.




