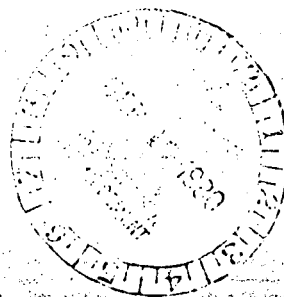

Subject: IE Bulletin 80-20

San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station
Units 2 and 3

Your letter of July 31, 1980 forwards IE Bulletin 80-20, "Failures of Westinghouse Type W-2 Spring Return to Neutral Control Switches" and requests information (within 45 days of the date of the bulletin) regarding extent of use at San Onofre Units 2 and 3 and long term corrective actions, if applicable.

SCE has contacted both the A/E (Bechtel) and NSSS supplier (CE) regarding use of this equipment. Although a preliminary review by our A/E indicates the subject switches are not used at San Onofre Units 2 and 3, information from subvendors to Bechtel and CE is still outstanding and, as such, no final determination can be made at this time. Should information from Bechtel and CE indicate the switches are utilized, we will forward a second letter to you stating so and providing our plans for any necessary corrective actions.



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
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Per the NRC request contained in the letter forwarding this bulletin, it is estimated that a total of 80 manhours (including SCE, Bechtel, CE and subvendor technical and administrative manhours) will be expended to determine the extent of use of this equipment at San Onofre Units 2 and 3. Any manhours needed for corrective action will be estimated at the time such action is determined to be necessary.
