Dear Sir or Madam:

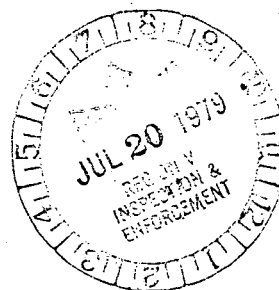

I expect to hear from you shortly.

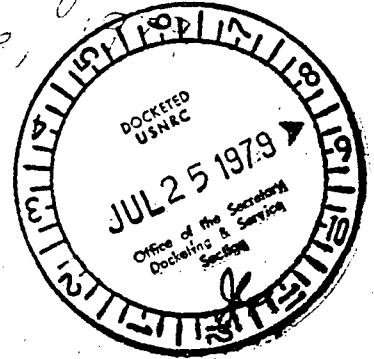

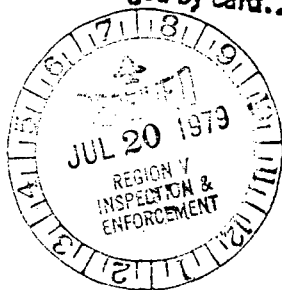
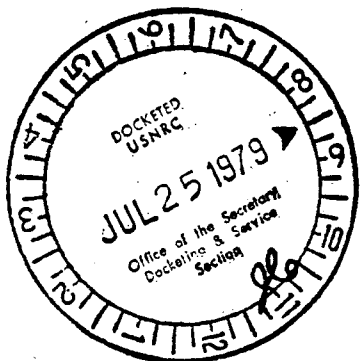
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

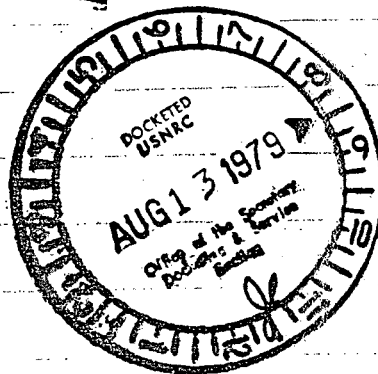
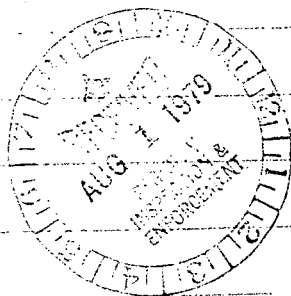
