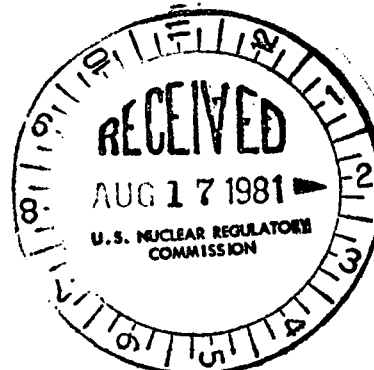

RESOLUTION

Conservation of Energy Resources

- WHEREAS, The Huntington Park Chamber of Commerce is vitally concerned that the economic, environmental and social well-being of the State of California be maintained; and
- WHEREAS, an adequate supply of energy is critical to meeting California's economic and social needs while preserving the environmental gains of the past decade; and
- WHEREAS, this nation's continued overdependence on foreign oil has caused major adverse economic impacts; and
- WHEREAS, there is a probability that instability in the Middle East will, at some near future time, result in reduced supplies of oil, thereby causing further social and economic chaos here at home, and
