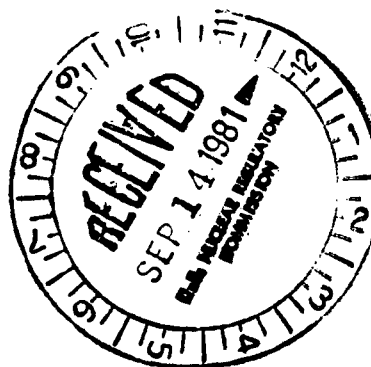
RESOLUTION
