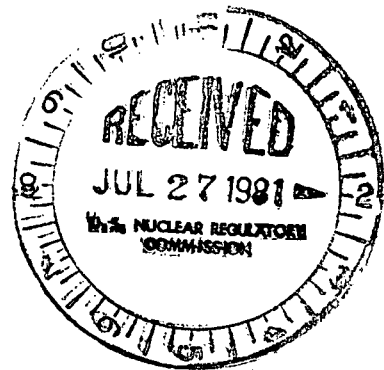

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE  
ALTADENA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
SUPPORTING LICENSING OF SAN ONOFRE UNITS II AND III

WHEREAS, The Altadena Chamber of Commerce is vitally concerned that the economic, environmental, and social well-being of the State of California be maintained, and

WHEREAS, an adequate supply of energy is critical to meeting California's economic and social needs while preserving the environmental gains of the past decade; and

WHEREAS, this nation's continued overdependence on foreign oil has caused major adverse economic impacts; and

WHEREAS, there is a probability that instability in the Middle East will, at some near future time, result in reduced supplies of oil, thereby causing further social and economic chaos here at home, and

WHEREAS, regulatory delays in the planning and licensing of needed energy facilities are costly to the consumer, damaging to the environment, and result in greater importation of foreign oil;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Altadena Chamber of Commerce supports licensing San Onofre Units II and III nuclear power plants, Units II and III.
