As a private school administrator, I feel it my duty to write requesting denial of the interim operating license of the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Stations, Units 2 and 3, until meaningful steps are taken to reduce both the likelihood and the potential consequences of an accident at San Onofre.

Data supplied by NRC show that a major accident at San Onofre could lead to 130,000 prompt deaths, 300,000 subsequent deaths from cancer, and 600,000 genetic defects.

It is also my understanding that the evacuation plans to transport children from this area are just in the beginning draft stages and still need to be tested. The local school district, Capistrano Unified School District, is anticipating eliminating transportation services in the near future. This action could gravely endanger our children in case of the need for evacuation during school hours.

It is imperative that these matters be fully resolved before licensing is considered.
