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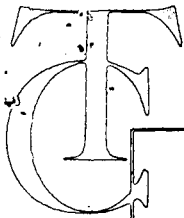

WHEREAS, we recognize that an adequate supply of electrical energy is critically important in meeting California's current and future needs; and




WHEREAS, California must maintain a strong commitment to providing balanced energy resources to serve the growing population of this state.
