Enclosed is a copy of the "Cook Book for Transportation Portions of Environmental Statements", which I described to you in our phonecon of August 16th. The format for McGuire is suggested.

As you know, the applicant has not specified the locations (a) from which new fuel will be shipped, (b) to which irradiated fuel will be sent for reprocessing, or (c) where rad-waste will be dumped. I have rechecked this point with Ken Baskin, and this situation has not changed. Therefore, I suggest that you use mileages (without specifying location) based on the following:

1. New fuel-from Connecticut
2. Irradiated fuel-to Illinois
3. Rad-waste-to Nevada

Obviously, either rail or truck shipment is feasible.

Some improvement in the accidental criticality section (VI B1., fourth paragraph) is recommended, and I suggest that your team address itself to this problem. Specifically, the statement that "--persons within a radius of about 100 feet from the accident might receive a serious exposure but beyond that distance, no detectable radiation effects would be likely.", is technically incorrect, and cannot be supported. A revision of this statement (and the next sentence) to define radii for fatal, serious, moderate, slight, and insignificant exposure is suggested.
