Cultural Resources, Memorandum of Agreement
San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station
Units 2 and 3

Reference is made to my letter dated October 29, 1979 in which it was stated that the Applicants are willing to be a party by signature to the proposed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA). The proposed MOA concerns cultural resources potentially subject to impact as a result of operation of the transmission lines for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3.

Applicants believe that the previous statement is perhaps ambiguous. Although the above referenced letter indicates a willingness on the part of the Applicants to sign the MOA, the proposed MOA is written to exclude the Applicants as parties to the agreement. Applicants do not believe that in the present instance it is appropriate that they sign the MOA. If either the Nuclear Regulatory Commission or the State Office of Historic Preservation has feelings to the contrary, we would certainly wish to discuss the matter.
