This Office has completed a review of the subject document with respect to HUD's mission to assist in the provision and preservation of safe and sound residential living environments.

We are currently processing an application for a proposed planned residential community project in San Clemente. The proposal is to develop approximately 2,500 dwelling units over a period of about 10 years.

As development opportunities continue to decline in central and northern areas of Orange County, it is expected that South Orange County will experience a substantial increase in housing supply during the next decade.

Because of the possibility of health impacts caused by the San Onofre facility, we suggest that the Final EIS include an Emergency Evacuation Plan for residents in the area where the probability of risk due to accidents at the plant is the greatest. In addition, the knowledge that an Emergency Evacuation Plan exists and has the administrative support necessary for implementation makes it easier for public agencies such as ourselves to carry out our planning and programmatic responsibilities.
