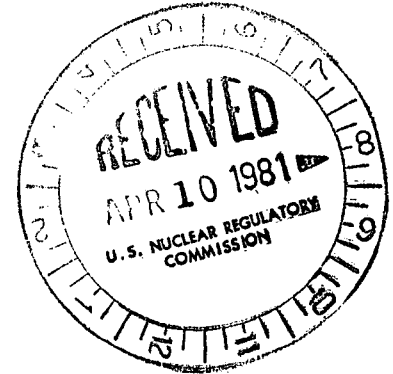
We request that you consider our position in your study and actions as they relate to the development of adequate and low cost energy supplies.

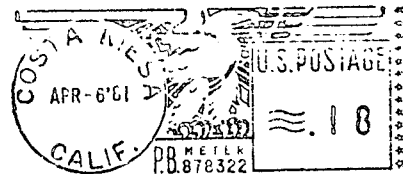
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mesa Consolidated Water District supports
