The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) letter dated July 2, 1984 requested from the Southern California Edison Company (SCE) the sum of \$1,600 in order to complete the fees due for Proposed Change Number NPF-10/15-144, a January 3, 1984 application formally submitted by letter dated January 25, 1984. SCE concurs with the NRC's assessment that Proposed Change Number NPF-10/15-144 requires the remittance of a Class III fee (\$4,000) and a Class I fee (\$400) for Units 2 and 3, respectively, rather than the Class II fee (\$1,200) and the Class I fee (\$400) which were remitted on January 25, 1984 with the above specified formal submittal letter. SCE also understands that a refund of \$1,200 is being provided for Proposed Change Number NPF-10-81, which was submitted by application dated June 7, 1983 with a Class II fee (\$1,200) and withdrawn by letter dated July 29, 1983. Because SCE agrees that Proposed Change Number NPF-10/15-144 requires a total fee of \$4,400 and understands that the previously remitted sum of \$1,600 and the approved refund of \$1,200 are being applied towards this fee, SCE is enclosing the balance of \$1,600 in order to complete the remittance of the requested fees.

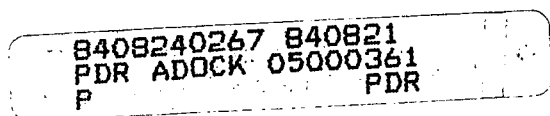
