Gentlemen:

Reference is made to my letter to Mr. D. Eisenhut dated July 1, 1981, Applicants' response to NRC Question No. 432.19 and discussions with NRC staff reviewer, John Sears. As stated in these references, the on-shift staffing of the SONGS 2 and 3 emergency response organization will comply with applicable NRC regulations and guidance. The purpose of this letter is to resolve the outstanding staffing open item that deals with the ability of Applicants to meet the 30-minute augmentation guidance in NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1 (Rev. 1), Table B-1.

From the start of fuel load for Unit 2 to July 1, 1982, the level of emergency response staffing will be that required by NRC Generic Letter 81-10, dated February 18, 1981. By July 1, 1982, the minimum shift crew available to initially respond to an emergency will be as set forth in Table 5-2 of the SONGS 2 and 3 Emergency Plan. These minimum shift manning levels satisfy the guidance set forth in Table B-1.

The minimum shift manning levels discussed above can be augmented by additional off-shift SONGS personnel. SCE has determined that eleven qualified personnel, capable of performing the functions listed in NUREG-0654, Table B-1, under capability

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for 30 minutes, would be present within 30 minutes. The difference between this position and that stated in the response to NRC Question 432.19 is that this position takes credit for utilizing either available contract HP personnel or qualified SCE site engineering personnel to fulfill some of the functional requirements of offsite and onsite (out-of-plant) radiological surveys. All required personnel listed in Table B-1, under capability for 60 minutes, would be present within 60 minutes.
