Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 30.38, Sharp Electronics Corporation ("Sharp") hereby applies for an amendment to NRC License No. 29-24002-01E to remove the facility located at 1300 Naperville Drive, Romeoville, Illinois. Sharp has discontinued distribution of projector lamps containing Krypton -85 from the Romeoville facility.

On or before September 12, 2013, all Krypton-85 projector lamp inventory that was remaining at the Romeoville facility was shipped to either customers, Sharp's distribution facility in Rancho Cucamonga, California, Sharp's Refurbishment Center in Reynosa Tamaulipas NS, Mexico, or TAK Repair (repair contractor for Sharp) in Memphis, TN.

Sharp has taken the actions required by Illinois regulations to terminate its Illinois possession license for the Romeoville facility and submitted a Certificate of Termination to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, Division of Nuclear Safety on October 28, 2013.
