Special Report
San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3

Pursuant to Section 3.12.2, Action Statement 'a', of Appendix A, Technical Specifications to Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-10 and NPF-15 for San Onofre Units 2 and 3, respectively, this submittal provides the required 30-day written Special Report for conditions identified during the July 1984 Land Use Census.

The Preliminary Land Use Census received by SCE on August 10, 1984, reports that the San Onofre State Beach Park Campground (Sector G) land use should now reflect the presence of campsites (tents) at a distance of 0.8 mile, rather than the previous distance of 1.4 miles. This change will be reflected in the Offsite Dose Calculation Manual, changes in which are submitted to the NRC in accordance with Technical Specification 6.14.2.1. The significance of the change will be an increase in the calculated dose commitment calculated at this location.

The preliminary report also advises that a U.S. Marine Corps contract exists which permits a private firm to graze sheep in several sectors adjacent to the plant for up to six months per year. Our investigation is continuing, awaiting receipt of written confirmation containing details of the contract and a description of actual sheep grazing locations. To date, no sheep have actually been sighted within the Land Use Census area.
