The purpose of this letter is to advise the NRC of the current status of the Southern California Edison Company (SCE) Detailed Control Room Design Review Supplemental Report and to inform the NRC of a necessary delay in the expected submittal date from October 31, 1985 to January 31, 1986.

The week of June 17, 1985, the NRC conducted an in-progress audit of SCE's DCRDR Supplemental Report effort to assess the degree to which the supplemental report will satisfy the NRC's information and documentation requirements. During the Audit, the NRC identified several items needing additional development prior to submittal of the DCRDR Supplemental Report. These are:

- 1) Formal, documented methodology for evaluation and disposition of Human Engineering Discrepancies (HED's),
- 2) Documentation of the selection of design improvements,
- 3) Documentation for verification of HED corrections, and
- 4) Coordination plan for integration of NUREG-0737 Supp. 1 activities, Reg Guide 1.97 and other control room modifications with the DCRDR project.

The items identified by the NRC during this week long audit as requiring additional documentation by the DCRDR Task Force, combined with the time lost in preparation for the audit has resulted in the need to revise SCE's DCRDR Supplemental Report submittal date to January 31, 1986.

The decision to revise the submittal date was also based on concerns voiced by J. Kramer (NRC) during the NRC exit interview held on June 21, 1985. While indicating that the existing schedule was adequate to meet the pre-audit

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DCRDR Supplemental Report project scope, the NRC indicated that extending the scheduled submittal date was desirable to ensure complete compliance with NRC information and documentation requirements.

SCE considers this schedule change to be prudent and necessary to provide a complete DCRDR Supplemental Report in light of the items detailed above.
