The NRC is presently preparing a summary of radioactive effluents released from commercial nuclear power plants during 1976. The report will be similar to NUREG-0218, "Radioactive Materials Released from Nuclear Power Plants (1975)".

In order to verify the accuracy of the information before its publication, a draft copy of the data with respect to your plant(s) is enclosed for your review. We would appreciate receiving your comments and suggested changes by September 16, 1977.
