The San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 2 Facility Operating License (License No. NPF-10) contains License Condition (20) relative to the Surveillance Program, which indicates that prior to entering any operational mode for the first time, including initial fuel loading, SCE shall:

- (a) Have completed a review of the surveillance procedures applicable to the change of mode, and determined that the procedures demonstrate the operability of the required systems with respect to all acceptance criteria defined in the Technical Specifications.
- (b) Have dispatched written certification to the NRC Regional Administrator, Region V, that the actions defined in (a) above have been completed for the mode or modes to be entered.

In accordance with this license condition, the purpose of this letter is to certify to you that SCE has completed a review of the San Onofre Unit 2 surveillance procedures necessary for initial entry into MODE 2, and has determined that these procedures demonstrate the operability of the required systems with respect to the applicable acceptance criteria defined in the Technical Specifications.
