Dear Ms. Quinn:

On September 30, 2008, Nine Mile Point 3 Nuclear Project, LLC, and UniStar Nuclear Operating Services, LLC, (co-applicants) submitted a combined license (COL) application to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for one new reactor unit, Unit 3, to be located adjacent to the existing Nine Mile Point Units 1 and 2. On October 6, 2008, the NRC requested the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to perform a review of the offsite emergency planning information, as part of NRC's review and proposed issuance of a COL. On December 1, 2009, UniStar Nuclear Energy (UNE), on behalf of the co-applicants, requested that the NRC temporarily suspend its review of the COL application.

On November 26, 2013, UNE withdrew the COL application for Nine Mile Point Unit 3. The NRC will shortly publish a Federal Register notice announcing this withdrawal. No further effort is to be expended on this COL application.
