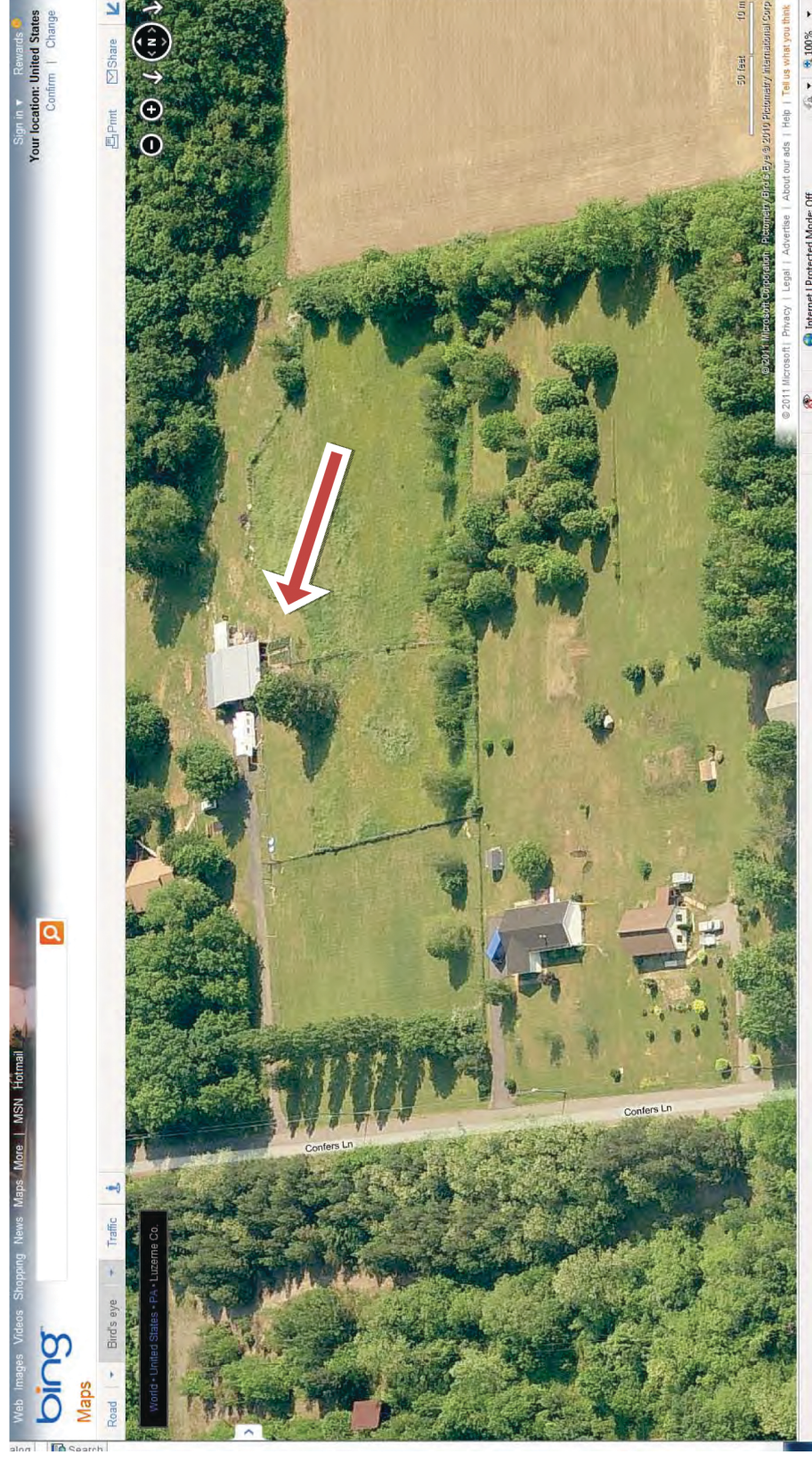


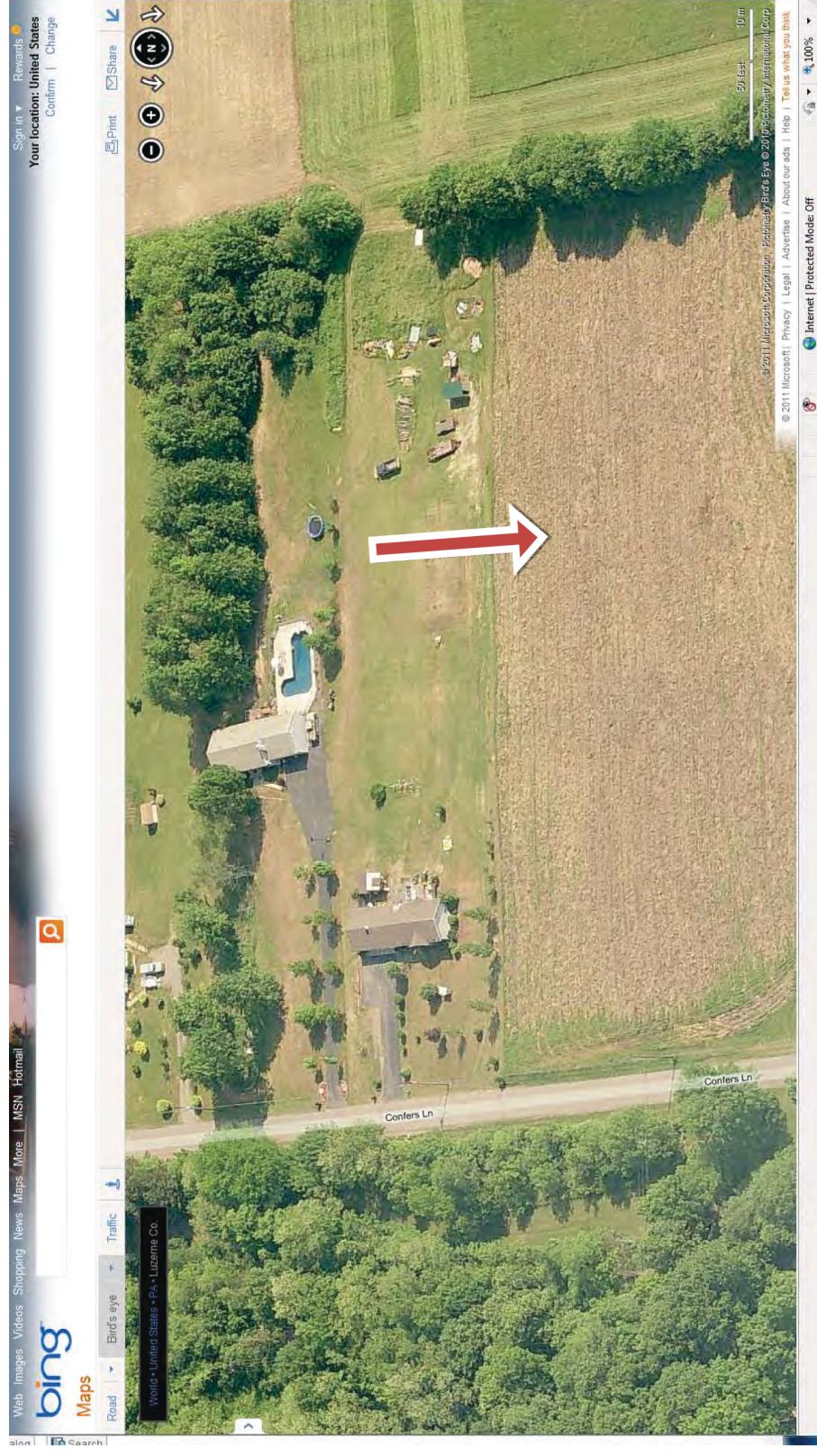
Annual Offsite Dose to Individuals from Gaseous Effluent Releases from the U.S. EPR for Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plan

SE Garden (1st photo): The photo shows, at the top center, what appears to be a garden on the south side of the house/barn (at -76.155636, 41.078452). This is closer than, and conservatively supersedes, the large tilled area just to the south of this area, in the next photo. Note also that this garden was not listed in the SSES 2010 Land Use Census, but had other more distant gardens listed for this sector and the adjacent sector. Assuming this closer garden (in photo) is real is therefore conservative.



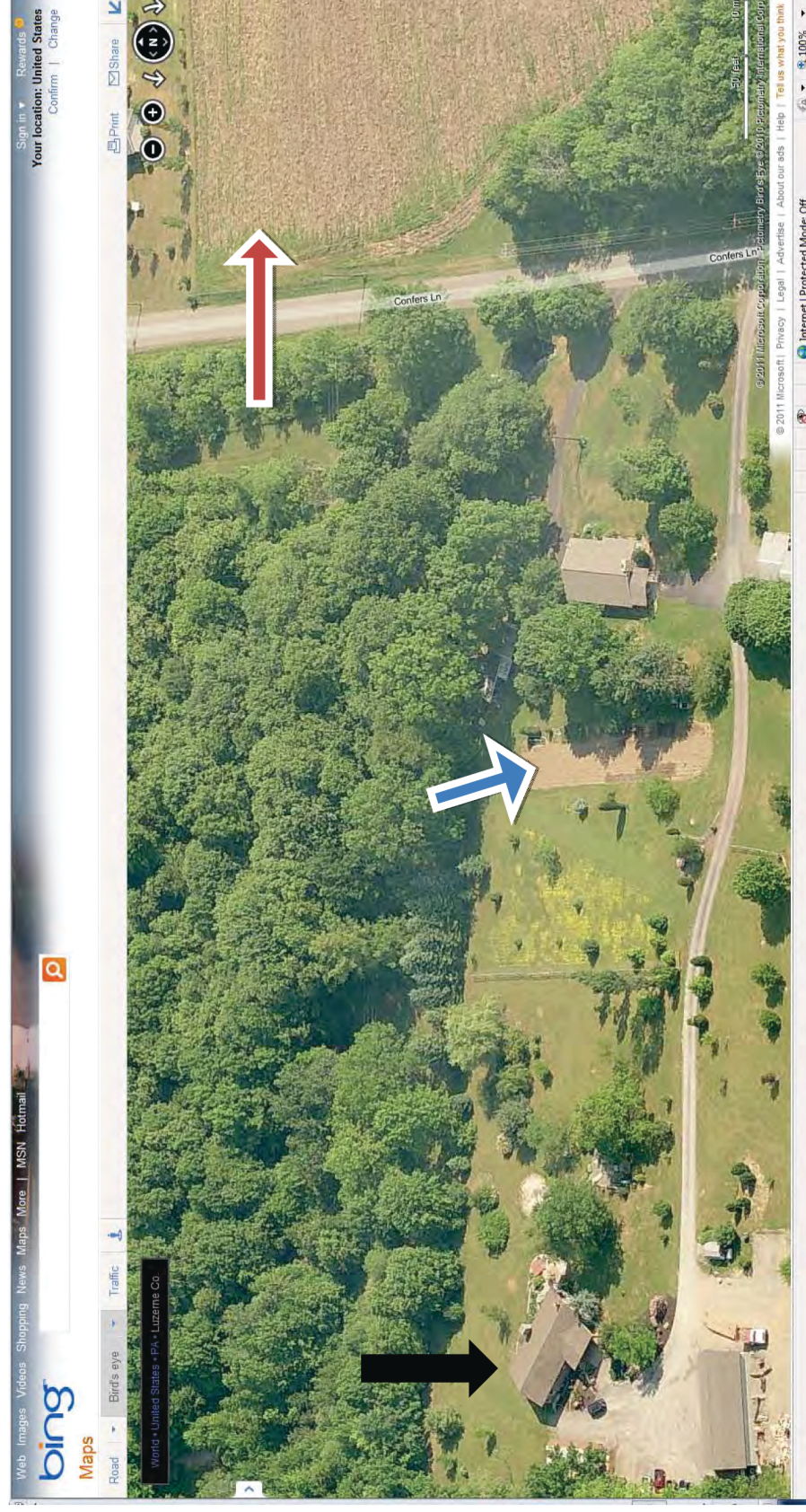

SE Garden (2nd photo): This photo shows the tilled area (-76.155137, 41.076399) just to the south of the selected garden in the photo above. This garden was NOT selected as the nearest garden in this sector.

SSE Garden & Residence: The garden [small blue arrow] to the left of the house in the lower center of the photo is the nearest garden (-76.157646, 41.075421) to SSES in the SSW sector, as identified in the SSES 2010 Land Use Census. However, the tilled area [large red arrow] in the right part of the photo (approx. -76.156620, 41.076319) is in the same sector (SSE) as the aforementioned garden, but is slightly closer, and is therefore used as the nearest garden. The house at the far left of the photo [medium size black arrow] is the nearest residence for this sector (-76.158889, 41.075505).

S Residence: The residence is shown in the center of the photo (-76.163037, 41.073420).

S Garden: The field in the upper center of the photo (-76.167379, 41.081751) is inside the property boundary, but is outside of the BBNPP Limit of Disturbance. It is therefore conservatively assumed to be available for farming in the future, even though crops do not appear to be growing at the time of the photo.
