Ron, Uranium One would like to schedule a conference call with you and other appropriate managers as soon as possible to discuss the transfer and storage of drummed yellowcake from our Honeymoon facility in Australia to our Willow Creek facility in Wyoming. The Honeymoon facility was recently placed in care and maintenance and must move the yellowcake to a secure facility, preferably owned by Uranium One and within the U.S. The material from Honeymoon will eventually require transfer from Willow Creek to a U.S. or Canadian converter (ConverDyn or Cameco Blind River). However, the Honeymoon material contains small amounts of organic residual from the solvent extraction process that is above each converter's rejection limit for their processes. Therefore Uranium One also wishes to discuss with you the potential for reprocessing (additional drying – calcining) of this material at our Willow Creek facility. This is of great importance to Uranium One so your immediate attention would be greatly appreciated.
