SUBJECT: FERMI, UNIT 2 - NRC SECURITY INSPECTION REPORT 05000341/2013201

Dear Mr. Plona:

On November 22, 2013, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed an inspection at your Fermi Unit 2. The inspection covered one or more of the key attributes of the security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. The enclosed inspection report documents the inspection results, which were discussed via telephone on December 12, 2013, with Mr. James T. Conner and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

One NRC-identified finding of very low security significance (i.e., Green as determined by the Physical Protection Significance Determination Process) was identified during this inspection. The deficiency was promptly corrected or compensated for, and the plant was in compliance with applicable physical protection and security requirements within the scope of this inspection before the inspectors left the area. The finding was determined to involve violations of NRC requirements. However, the NRC is treating the violations as a non-cited violation (NCV) consistent with Section 2.3.2 of the NRC Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the NCV in the enclosed report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region III, the Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR), and the Director, Office of Enforcement, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; and the NRC Resident Inspector at Fermi 2 Station.

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One cross-cutting aspect was assigned to this finding, in the area of Human Performance, associated with work practices [(H.4(a)].
