

SUBJECT: MEETING BETWEEN THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY
COMMISSION STAFF AND STAKEHOLDERS ON THE
IMPLEMENTATION OF TITLE 10 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL
REGULATIONS PART 51, SUBPART A, APPENDIX B,
TABLE B-1

On December 9, 2013, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI), utility groups, and other stakeholders at NRC headquarters concerning the implementation of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Part 51, Appendix B, Table B-1. The recently revised Table B-1 is a summary of findings on National Environmental Policy Act issues for license renewal of nuclear power plants. A public meeting notice was issued on November 14, 2013, and was posted on the NRC's external (public) web page (ADAMS Accession No. ML13316C223). The notice included the meeting agenda, which was also available as a handout at the meeting.

The NRC staff presented an overview of the revisions to the Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants (NUREG-1437) and Table B-1 (Enclosure 2). The floor was then opened to meeting attendees for a question and answer session with NRC staff. Attendees were asked to keep questions related to the clarification of changes to Table B-1 and its implementation. Kathy Yhip of NEI asked a series of clarifying questions concerning the acceptability of information provided by applicants in their environmental reports in accordance with the revised Table B-1. Follow-up questions were asked by: Rick Buckley, Entergy; Nancy Ranek, Exelon Generation; and Jim Thomas, Enercon. Resource areas covered during this discussion included in-scope transmission lines, groundwater, aquatic resources, alternatives, environmental justice, green house gas

emissions, and noise. NRC staff emphasized that all submittals must conform to requirements found in 10 CFR Part 51 and applicants should look to NRC Regulatory Guide 4.2 for method, process, data, or format of information that the NRC staff has found to be acceptable to meet the requirements specified in the regulations.
