Affiant is personally familiar with the trade secrets and privileged information contained in the attached supplementary information, hereafter referred to as the Proprietary Supplement, and requests that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, pursuant to Chapter 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 2.790 (10CFR2.790) "Public Inspections, Exemptions, Request for Withholding," withhold the information contained within said proprietary volume from public disclosure.
2. This information has been and is held in confidence by PSN.
3. The information contained within the proprietary volume is calculated data, results of design calculations and components design details and critical dimensions which were developed by PSN. This type of information is normally held in confidence by those who invest time and money in its development.
4. The information has been transmitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in confidence under separate cover in a separate document which contains a proprietary information statement.
5. The information which is being claimed as trade secrets and privileged information is not available in public sources.

6. PSN has invested a considerable amount of time, engineering manpower and money in the development of the information contained in the proprietary volume. Public disclosure of this information would cause substantial harm to PSN's competitive position. Others, seeking to design similar storage systems, would have to make similar investments to develop the information on their own as long as the information is not disclosed to the public.

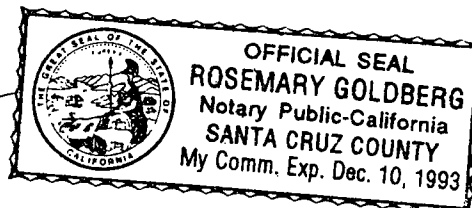
