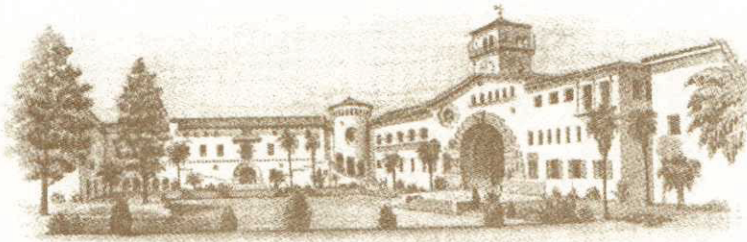

Dear Commission:

I am writing to you today to show support for PG&E's successful spent fuel management program and the NRC's Spent Fuel Storage Rule. As a 30 year resident and father of 3 young children, I take immense pride in knowing PG&E is actively taking great care and precaution to keep us safe. Their site at Diablo Canyon is safe for residents AND for their workforce who employ hundreds throughout our community.

Again, I am in complete support of the NRC's Spent Fuel Storage Rule and have witnessed firsthand that with NRC oversight PG&E has a *very* detailed and successful spent fuel management program who continues to safely store fuel via both its wet and dry cask storage systems. Through my personal tour of the facility as Chief of Staff, I am confident that numerous safeguards are in place to manage and monitor the stored spent fuel. However, the Department of Energy has a responsibility to make good on its commitment to receive and safely store the spent fuel for the long term. By doing so, locally stored spent fuel could be safely removed to a single or regional locations controlled by AND protected by our national government until a cost effective way of recycling portions of the stored fuel can be determined and realized.
